How to Fly your Flag

Instructions for attaching and flying you flag from your flagpole





Attaching and hoisting a flag from a flagpole with an internal halyard (rope)

The rope goes at the inside of the pole and emerges from the top

- 1. Start with the up-haul end of the rope down at ground level.
- 2. Pass the toggle (on the top corner of your flag) though the loop at the end of the rope.
- 3. Follow the headband until you reach the tail line.
- 4. Tie a small loop in the tail line, about the size of your thumb.
- 5. Now attach the weight. This is usually a collar.

- 6. You are now ready to hoist. Keeping halyard taught, gently pull on the up-haul rope, which emerges from the small hatch on the flagpole.
- 7. Keeping halyard taught, hoist flag until toggle reaches finial (top).
- 8. Tuck all remaining rope inside flagpole.
