Platinum Jubilee Celebration – A Gallop Through History

12 May 2022

Windsor Castle, Berkshire

In celebration of Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee in 2022, a very special event will take place in the private grounds of Windsor Castle from 12th to 15th May.

The Celebration will see more than 500 horses and 1000 performers create a 90-minute piece of spellbinding arena theatre that will include actors and artists, musicians, international military displays from the Commonwealth, Europe and our own Armed Forces, dancers and global equestrian displays.

Victoria and Albert Museum, Cromwell Road, London

The Victoria and Albert Museum is displaying the award winning design of The V&A Platinum Jubilee Emblem Competition, along with the other nine shortlisted emblem design entries, at the V&A in London in June 2022.



The Queen's Birthday Parade (Trooping the Colour)

2 June 2022

Buckingham Palace, London

More than 1,400 parading soldiers, 200 horses and 400 musicians will come together in the traditional Parade to mark The Queen's official birthday, usually held on the second Saturday in June.

Beginning at Buckingham Palace, the Parade will move down The Mall to Horse Guard's Parade, joined by members of the Royal Family on horseback and in carriages. The Parade will close with the traditional RAF fly-past, watched by The Queen and members of the Royal Family from the Buckingham Palace balcony.



Service of Thanksgiving

3 June 2022

St Paul's Cathedral, St. Paul's Churchyard, London

A Service of Thanksgiving for Her Majesty The Queen's reign will be held at St Paul's Cathedral. The Service will not be open to the public. Further events will be announced in due course.



Platinum Party at the Palace

4 June 2022

Buckingham Palace, London

The BBC will stage and broadcast a special live concert from Buckingham Palace that will bring together some of the world's biggest entertainment stars to celebrate the most significant and joyous moments from The Queen's seven decade reign. Members of the public will be invited to apply to attend this special event. Details of the ballot for UK residents to secure audience tickets will be released in due course.



Platinum Jubilee Pageant

5 June 2022

Buckingham Palace, London

A pageant featuring over 5,000 people from across the UK and the Commonwealth will take place against the backdrop of Buckingham Palace and the surrounding streets. It will combine street arts, theatre, music, circus, carnival and costume and celebrate Her Majesty's reign, as well as honouring the collective service of people and communities across the country.
