Design Your Own Jubilee Flag

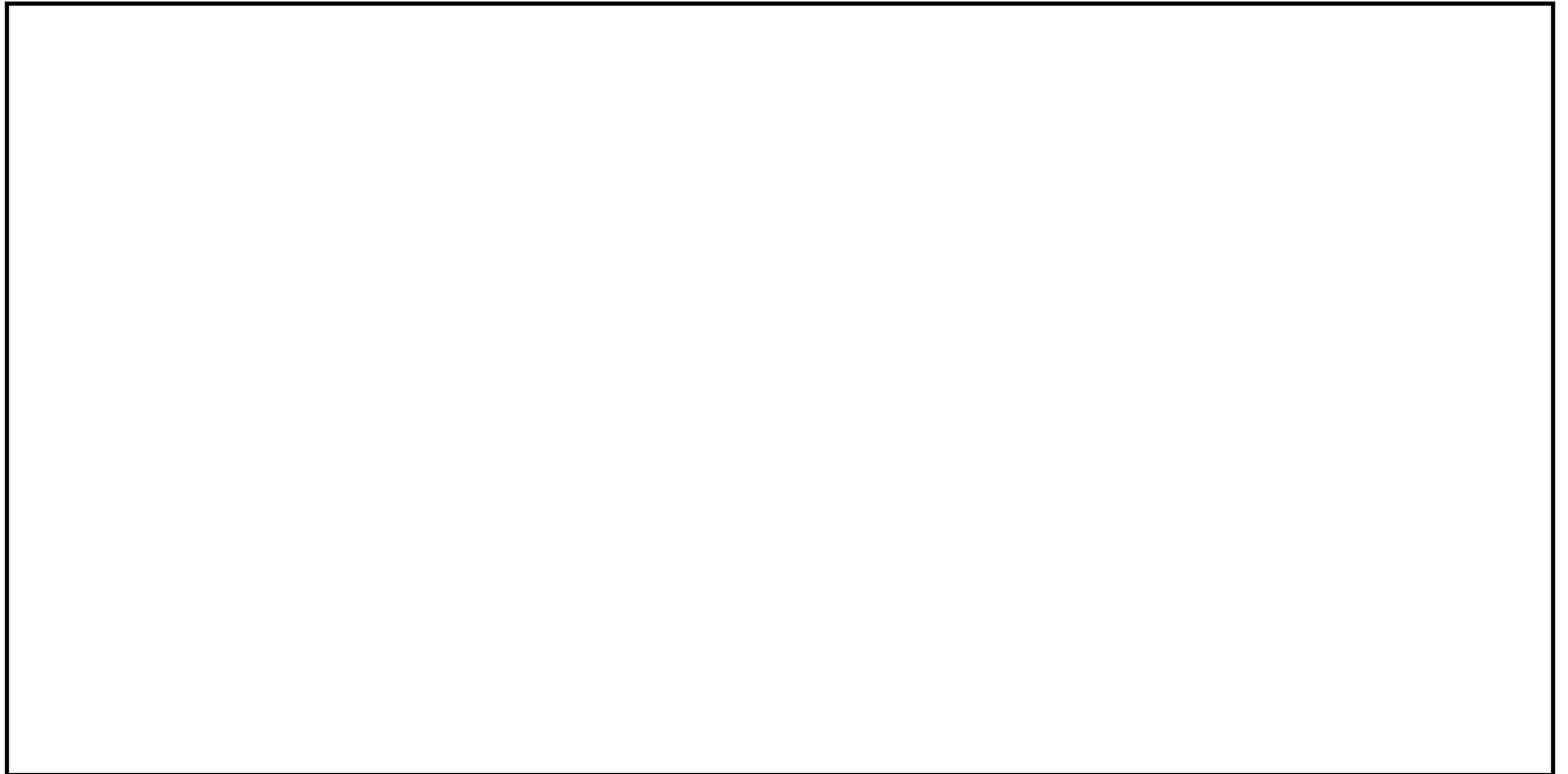
